

The Blessing of Abraham

Abraham

Genesis 22:17-18

"Indeed, I will greatly bless you, and (A) I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and (B) your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies. (C) In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed..."

Isaac

Genesis 26:3-4

"Sojourn in this land and I will be with you and bless you, for to you and to your descendants I will give all these lands, and I will establish the oath which I swore to your father Abraham. (A) I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven, and (B) will give your descendants all these lands; and (C) by your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed."


Jacob

Genesis 28:13-14

And behold, Adonai stood above it and said, "I am Adonai, the God of your father Abraham and the God of Isaac; (B) the land on which you lie, I will give it to you and to your descendants. (A) Your descendants will also be like the dust of the earth, and you will spread out to the west and to the east and to the north and to the south; and (C) in you and in your seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed."

Three Elements:


- A** – Establishing the nation
- B** – Inheriting the Land of Israel
- C** – Being a light/blessing to the nations





Hebrews 3:1

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Yeshua, the **Apostle** and **High Priest** of our confession;



John 1:47-51

Yeshua saw Nathanael coming to Him, and said of him, “Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!” Nathanael said to Him, “How do You know me?” Yeshua answered and said to him, “Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.” Nathanael answered Him, “Rabbi, You are the Son of God; You are the King of Israel.” Yeshua answered and said to him, “Because I said to you that I saw you under the fig tree, do you believe? You will see greater things than these.” And He said to him, “Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see the heavens opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.”

The Place

הַמָּקוֹם

(*ha'makom*)

Genesis 28:11

He came to a certain **place** and spent the night there, because the sun had set; and he took one of the stones of the **place** and put it under his head, and lay down in that **place**.

Genesis 28:16-19

Then Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, “Surely Adonai is in this **place**, and I did not know it.” He was afraid and said, “How awesome is this **place**! This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven.” So Jacob rose early in the morning, and took the stone that he had put under his head and set it up as a pillar and poured oil on its top. He called the name of that **place** Bethel...

- ✓ 2 – Building
- ✓ 3 – Naming

Genesis 22

v.4 - On the third day Abraham raised his eyes and saw the **place** from a distance.

v.9 - Then they came to the **place** of which God had told him; and Abraham built the altar there and arranged the wood, and bound his son Isaac and laid him on the altar, on top of the wood.

v.14 - Abraham called the name of that **place** Adonai Yireh, as it is said to this day, “In the mount of Adonai it will be seen.”

Genesis 35:13-15

Then God went up from him in the **place** where He had spoken with him. Jacob set up a pillar in the **place** where He had spoken with him, a pillar of stone, and he poured out a drink offering on it; he also poured oil on it. So Jacob named the **place** where God had spoken with him, Bethel.

- ✓ 1 – **Revelation**
- ✓ 2 – Building (or **Preparation**)
- ✓ 3 – Naming (or **Dedication**)

- 1 – **Pesach** (*Passover*)
- 2 – **Shavuot** (*Pentecost*)
- 3 – **Sukkot** (*Tabernacles*)
