The 10 Virgins + The “Talents”

(25:1-13) (25:14-30)

The Sheep & The Goats (25:31-46)

Signs of an evil servant:

- Abuses his fellow workers
- Eats & Drinks with drunkards

Future of an evil servant:

- Will be “cut up”, i.e. “flogged” (Luke 12:47-48)
- Placed with the hypocrites (Matthew 23)

“Who is the **faithful and wise** servant...?”

πιστος
(pistos)

θρονιμος
(thronimos)

The 10 Virgins

“**wise virgins**”
(25:2,4,8,9)

The “Talents”

“**Faithful servant**”
(25:21,23)

“hard” = σκληρός (sklei-ros)

John 6:60 When many of His disciples heard it, they said, “This is a **hard** saying; who can listen to it?”

Acts 26:14 “... It is **hard** for you to kick against the goads.”

James 3:4 Look at the ships also: though they are so large and are driven by **strong** winds...

Jude 1:15 ... the **harsh** things that ungodly sinners have spoken against him."

Errors of the Faithless (Lazy) Servant:

- **Did not know his Master**
- **Committed the sin of fear**
- **Refused to make a decision**
- **Failed to seek and to follow council**

Similarities:

- Both groups awaited someone's return
- Both groups given time to prepare
- $5+5=10$
- Some "enter", while others "left outside"
- Light and Darkness
- No excuses

Differences:

• "I never knew you"	"wicked & lazy"
• Interaction	no interaction
• 10 becomes 5	5 becomes 10
• Females	Males
