John 4:40

So when the Samaritans came to him, they asked him to stay with them, and he stayed there **two days**.

Luke 21:24

They will fall by the edge of the sword and be led captive among all nations, and Jerusalem will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles, until **the times of the Gentiles** are fulfilled.

“He descended from the mountain...”

Occurs **8x** in the Tanach

Occurs **2x** in the Gospels

Exodus 32:15

Then Moses turned and went **down from the mountain** with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand...

Exodus 34:29

When Moses **went down from Mount** Sinai, with the two tablets of the testimony in his hand as he came down from the mountain, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because he had been talking with God.

Moses' two descents = Yeshua's two descents

A Lesson from the Leper

Luke 5:12

While He was in one of the cities, there came a man **full of leprosy**. And when he saw Yeshua, he fell on his face and begged Him, “Master, if You will, You can make me clean.”

Leviticus 13:12-13

And if the leprous disease breaks out in the skin, so that the leprous disease covers all the skin of the diseased person from head to foot, so far as the priest can see, then the priest shall look, and **if the leprous disease has covered all his body, he shall pronounce him clean of the disease; it has all turned white, and he is clean.**

Philippians 3:4-6

...though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the Torah, a Pharisee; as to zeal, a persecutor of the *kahal*; **as to righteousness under the Torah, blameless.**

Matthew 23:27

“Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs, which **outwardly** appear beautiful, but **within** are full of dead people’s bones and all uncleanness.”

Psalm 24:3-5

Who shall ascend the hill of Adonai?
And who shall stand in His holy place?

He who has **clean hands** and...
a pure heart,

who does not lift up his soul to what is false...
and does not swear deceitfully.

He will receive blessing from Adonai and...
righteousness from the God of his salvation
[Yeshua].
